Note

1. After being approved by the program director, International College (IC) students are allowed to take courses offered by other programs of IC or English-taught courses or second foreign language courses offered by departments of other colleges up to 17 credits. Non-English-taught courses also need the approval from the program director
 2. Additional general education and educational program credits are not counted as graduation credits for IC students. Additional IC elective credits are counted as optional elective graduation credits. The regulation can be applied to students entering IC before 2015 academic year..
 3. Students have to take at least 12 core elective credits before graduation; it should include at least one subject from “Social Sciences”, one subject from “Natural Sciences & Mathematics”, one subjects from “Humanity & Arts”, one subject from “Cross Field General Education Category”..
 4. Professional required and elective credits of each program can not be counted as IC core elective credits.
 5. All International freshmen or first-year students can waive “Basic English Listening and Oral Communication” and “Basic English Reading and Grammar” , if meeting IC entrance English proficiency requirement or with an English proficiency certificate of at least TOEIC 600/ TOEFL 500 / IBT61, IELTS 5 or GEPT – Intermediate Level.
 6. International freshmen or first-year students may, upon approval by the program director, waive “English Reading and Composition-I” and “English Reading and Composition-II” and take Chinese related courses of equal credits, instead if one of the following can be provided within the first two weeks of the semester: (1) Certificate of TOFEL 580, IELTS 6.0 or equal proficiency level, (2) document indicating English as the language
 7. Before graduation from Ming Chuan University, students who hold Form-5 high school diploma before admitted to MCU are required to take at least a total of 12 credits of elective courses using English as the language of instruction.
 8. Students with Form 5 diploma are required to take 12 additional English-taught credits in addition to regular graduation credits.
 9. This course outline applies to students entering in Fall 2013. Elective courses on this course curriculum university prior to Fall 2014.may be counted toward total graduation credits by students who entered the university prior to Fall 2014.
 10. Students whose native language is same as the courses of Second language I and/or Second language II, after having been approved by the IAD committee, can take other courses which are approved by IAD in place of Second language I and/or Second language II.
- Students whose native languages are Second Foreign Language (1) or Second Foreign Language (2) are allowed to take other courses approved by the program director. The regulation can be applied to students entering IC before 2015 academic year.
